



Choose to Reuse with a **reusable** **to-go box**

In an effort to reduce landfill waste we've introduced new reusable to-go containers! These are in addition to what we've already been doing such as tray less dining halls, fair trade products, and paper products made of recycled materials. Help save the planet and grab a container at the Marketplace/Community Dining front desk.

If you are interested in participating in this program, please note the following details:

- When you sign up, you will receive your first, clean container.
- Reusable containers can be used at **Community at Lincoln Center** and **Marketplace at Rose Hill** only. At this time, we are only allowing usage at these locations so we can ensure a smooth introduction of the program.
- You will only be allowed to use a clean container in the dining halls; therefore, in order to continue to participate, you must return the container you have (clean, rinsed out, dirty - we don't care) and you will receive a new, clean container. (You will NOT be able to use any clean containers you bring to these locations from outside, only clean containers we provide at the door. This is very important to maintain a dining program that is compliant with NYC Department of Health code.)
- When you return the containers you have and get a new, clean one, you can then use it for your take-out meal - return this container, and receive a clean container at your next meal.
- You will only receive a new, clean container when you return the container already in your possession. We will not issue a container without the return of one you already have. Similarly, if you return a container and receive a new one, you must either use it at that meal, or return this container, even if you did not use it for a meal, for a new one at a later date. Again, this is to ensure that the containers used for takeout are clean. While we trust you when you say you washed the container out, we must stick to our very strict standard in this matter.
- If you do not wish to carry a dirty container until your next takeout meal, you can return the dirty container at the register at Community Dining or Marketplace and receive a small key tag. You can then provide this key tag, in exchange for a clean container the next time you want to have a takeout meal.

The cost to participate is a one-time fee of \$5.99, payable using cash, credit or DB (this charge helps ensure active participation in the program and prevents disposal of the containers.) If you lose a container or key tag but wish to continue, you will have to sign up for the program again.
